A DonMentia Forum is an informal gathering for people with a diagnosis of dementia, together with their carers/loved ones. Lasting about two hours, it is simply an opportunity for people to meet over a cup of tea or coffee (and possibly biscuits or maybe even cake!). All provided free, courtesy of DonMentia, your local dementia specialist charity.

DonMentia has been providing this service at Tickhill Road Hospital Centre for some years (except during Lockdown) on a monthly basis, but now at Scawsby Community Centre – on the second Wednesday of each month. All are welcome, wherever you live. Please see our website for full details.

The feedback is always very positive with people able to compare experiences (if they so choose) and even learn from each other about the various services that are on offer from a range of organisations in the public and private sector. Or just have a chat.

Occasionally we have a guest speaker who might talk for approximately fifteen minutes or so about something which you should find informative. Last month in Scawsby we had someone from DMBC talking about help and assistance for carers and grants that are available.

DonMentia is now seeking to expand the idea to other locations across the Doncaster Borough and The Old School in Barnby Dun is to be the first of our new locations.
